Cooperation between sections in the form of interdisciplinary panels (ideally consisting of 3-6 presentations) are especially welcome.

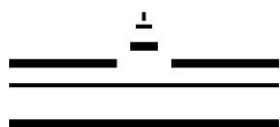
To register, submit the following information as doc/odt and as pdf document by e-mail to dot2013@uni-muenster.de:

- The presenter's name, address, institutional affiliation, and the name of institution that granted his/her highest degree
- Title of the presentation and a brief abstract (ca. 250 words)
- The desired section and, if applicable, the title of the panel and the name of the panel organizer

Submission deadline: 31 March 2013

Those who register and pay before 31 May 2013 are eligible for a fee of 80 € (reduced 40 €). Those who register and pay later, must pay 100 € (reduced 50 €) before the beginning of the conference.
